• Report concludes development of lots 37 and 38 can be undertaken with noted conditions without causing an undesirable effect on water quality and recreational capacity.

Thurston, L.D.W. 1978 **Summer and Winter Creel Census** on Selected Lake Trout Lakes in the Parry Sound District

- 178.5 man hours yielded 19 lake trout for a C.U.E. of 0.106 fish/hour
- 94% of fish taken were from the 1972 stocking and 3% were natural
- Lake represents fair angling quality

Michalski, M.F.P. 1974 Impact of Additional Cottage Development on Fairholme Lake

- Development will impact nutrient levels but phosphorous translocation can be considered minimal due to the setback.
- Cautions that in a geological time frame nutrients may gain access to the lake.

Management Prescription:

Managed as artificial lake trout fishery; natural, self-sustaining smallmouth bass fishery.
