- 6 man hours yielded 2 northern pike: pike were sought

Keller & Conroy, 1975 **The Quality of Selected Waters** In The Township of Foley Parry Sound District

- Based on ‘Lake Alert’ rankings, chlorophyll a and secchi disc relationships Haines lake is one of the most susceptible lakes to water quality impairment in the survey
- The lake is mesotrophic
